Multi Art Events creates artistic events, highlighting artistic creation in all its forms and in the diversity of its most striking trends.

Multi Art Gallery

Wendy Lauwers reinvented the concept of the traditional art gallery by adapting it to today's expectations. Multi Art Gallery is an online contemporary art gallery that offers its artists and collectors the same services as a traditional gallery.

Multi Art Gallery represents over hundred contemporary artists from all nationalities, each representative of a strong current in their own artistic discipline (painters, sculptors, photographers, designers...).

The online gallery also supports occasionally events organized in exceptional places. Many Multi Art Gallery artists have been with us for years and honor us with their trust.

ART Art Riviera Tour

The Monegasque online art gallery 'Multi Art Gallery' by Wendy Lauwers. Art Riviera Tour 'ART' is an ephemeral art exhibition that includes a rigorous selection of international artists.

The first edition of the temporary exhibition was launched in 2020 in Saint-Tropez. Its 5^h edition will take place in July 2024 in France in Saint-Jean-Cap-Ferrat.

Art Hugo Belgium

Hugo de Jesus (Art Hugo), born in 1975 in Antwerp, studied art and discovered large format techniques. He perfected his art of the simple line by working on the decoration of shop windows.

After a long pose, he returned to painting in 2021 and found his artistic path by specializing in the customization of XXL Playmobil. He works freehand and uses acrylic and posca.

His creations, in a patchwork style that does not conform to current artistic canons, are distinguished by the use of neon flash colors, angular lines and broad movements.

In 2023, he created the helmets for Formula E World Champion, Stoffel Vandoorne and World Cycling Champion, Remco Evenepoel. He also launched the Hugo Art Gallery.

Art Hugo is involved in many charities and associations for the benefit of children, women and disabled people and organizes many workshops for children.

Art Hugo exhibits his works in Belgium, Hungary, France, Monaco, Japan, and Dubai.

Jean-Claude Bertrand, French painter born in 1948, leads a pictorial adventure at the heart of our sensory memories. After exploring the worlds of music, perfume, nature, and humans, he is today interested in more environmental and spiritual issues.

He has exhibited in several countries in Europe, Switzerland, Monaco, and Canada.

The works presented at World Art Dubai 2024, "From Oil to Gold", evoke a journey through the ages of matter.

In the depths of the earth, oil lies dormant. Extracted, refined, it becomes fuel, a raw energy of modern life. Gold, at the other extreme, symbolizes wealth and beauty.

Matter is the common thread of our existence, the link between the past and the future, it is the canvas on which our dreams come to life.

By combining the colors of gold with a raw material made of tar and minerals, the artist offers an "object charged with spiritual vibrations," a metaphor for the alchemists' myth of lead changed into gold.


